Title of the Course: Identity Management

Credits: 4

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COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course covers biometrics, applicability of biometrics, best practices, and applicability of biometrics in government programs as an identification mechanism. The course also covers Smart Cards and RFID technology and applicability of these technologies in Identity Management. The course shall also focus on India's UIDAI project, Aadhaar enrolments, mechanisms to integrate Aadhaar into beneficiary databases and how a unique identifier can help Government deliver citizen service delivery schemes like direct cash transfer.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The basic objective of this course is to gain an understanding of various tools and technology available and commonly used to ensure Identity. This course will expose the participants to Biometrics, Smart Card, RFID technologies and their role in the Identity Management Space and comprehend Citizen Identity Management in different countries and several applications, like the Aadhaar, Border control and Banking. The course shall also provide participants an understanding on how to effectively address key factors which are responsible for the success of biometric system performance. The course shall also focus on the importance of proper design (with a reliable technology) in the implementation of large-scale biometric identity management projects to ensure delivery of reliable performance with enhanced security, convenience and meaningful ROI.

The course shall also introduce participants to the UIDAI, UID Program, Aadhaar Enrolment, Aadhaar Authentication and use of Aadhaar in Service Delivery to Residents, Direct Cast Transfer schemes and Aadhaar Seeding. This will help participants on understanding how to incorporate the UID authentication mechanism to establish identity of beneficiaries in an e-Gov Project and integration of Aadhaar into beneficiary databases.
