e-Governance

e-Governance (short for electronic government, also known as e-gov, digital government, online government, or connected government) is digital interaction between a government and citizens (G2C), government and businesses/commerce/eCommerce (G2B), and between government agencies (G2G), Government-to-Religious Movements/Church (G2R), Government-to-Households (G2H). This digital interaction consists of governance, information and communication technology (ICT), business process re-engineering (BPR), and e-citizen at all levels of government (city, state/provence, national, and international).

Essentially, the term e-Government or also known as Digital Government, refers to 'How government utilized IT, ICT and other telecommunication technologies, to enhance the efficiency and effectiveness in the public sector'

२. एकात्मिक संगणकीय माहिती प्रणालीची उद्दिष्टे :-

- १) विभागाच्या कामकाजातील विविध बाबी संगणकाद्वारे पार पाडणे.
- २) माहिती तंत्रज्ञानाद्वारे अचूक व जलदरित्या कामाचा निपटारा करून प्रशासनाची कार्यक्षमता वाढविणे.

४. आज्ञावली विकसन (Software Development)

1. **MWRD-ICIS Unified Portal** is an integral part of the ICIS solution and will act as gateway for various components/modules that are being incorporated into the solution. The proposed URL for accessing the ICIS portal is www.mahawrd.gov.in. A sample screenshot of the portal home page is shown above. The portal is designed to cater to the needs of different types of users logging into ICIS. The type of users are Farmers, Citizens, Business and WRD Employees. The portal allows users to create account and view the information accessible to them within the portal as per the defined access rights. Also, users can download WRD related forms / information in digital format or use online forms to communicate with department. Here, a general public user can find all the updated news and events of department. This portal also provides facility of online payment, thereby offering a more convenient experience to the users dealing with the payment transactions related to WRD. Portal also consists of Forum application for users to publish /exchange the knowledge and ideas on a variety of topics.

This portal shall be available in Marathi also. Hence, it is expected that the acceptability of the system will be more and the dissemination of the information on the portal will happen in a highly effective manner.

2. **The meeting management** module allows scheduling of meeting requests by all employees who are registered users.
3. **The Business Home page** is designed to cater to the various requirements of those users who are interested in or are already involved in a business relationship with MWRD. The business users can do e-procurement and e-payment in secured way, which will help both WRD and Business users to further strengthen the WRD's business relationships and processes. Business users can find upcoming projects and the status of the same on the portal.
4. **Citizens page** is designed to cater to the requirements of the general public with regards to the WRD portal. Citizens would typically access this page of the portal, seeking information about hydrological data, budget, flood and legislative assembly matters under this portion. Since the portal provides all the information in Marathi also, again it will be helpful for better understanding and acceptability of the portal by the common public.
5. **The Farmers page** is designed to cater to the various requirements of Farmers or Water User Associations. The Farmers can facilitate the online services, download the required forms, get the desired information about water tariff, entitlement, etc. from the portal. Again, since the portal provides all the information in regional language also, it will be helpful in better understanding and communication with the farmers and WUAs.
